Sacramento Valley Shooting Center is owned and operated by Folsom Shooting Club INC. SVSC is the premier outdoor shooting range on the West Coast and the largest and best privately held range West of the Mississippi.

Our ranges provide something for everyone. We provide facilities for shotgun, handgun and rifle shooters. Our 860+ acre facility has well over 400 firing positions and is home to many different sub disciplines. Our ranges are sought out by many world class shooters and we host several regional, national and international events every year.

Sacramento Valley Shooting Center is a world class facility with many private member only ranges. We also permit public access to our 100 and 300 yard rifle ranges, as well as our 50 yard pistol and .22 rim fire steel silhouette range.

Firearms are not available to rent at the range. You must bring your own firearms to shoot.

In addition to various shooting disciplines, there are a number of training classes and qualification courses offered. Check with the staff in the office if you are interested in any of these classes.

Our range also has a small lake with excellent fishing for members. There are gazebos at one end of the lake at Chizar Park where families and friends can gather for a picnic.

Range use since the last Board of Directors meeting has been great. As of the beginning of today's business day, we have had 3404 shooters, an increase from last month even with the cool weather. In addition, we have 119 new members to the club, bringing our total membership to 1333. The low number is due to memberships expiring. The number of members for the month of January is actually good. Last year, we had less than 1000 members through most of February. We will continue to grow.

The drawing for the Savage Model 12 Chambered in 6.5 Creedmoor is going strong. The raffle will continue to run until the BOD meeting on February 21st. Starting January 18th, we will begin selling tickets for a Glock 23 Gen4 Compact Pistol, 40 S&W, 4.02 in, Fixed Sights, 10 Rd, sponsored by Sacramento Black Rifle. The raffle will run for two months. The winning ticket will be drawn on March 20th, 2012.

We have completed the task of spreading gravel on the public pistol and the public rim fire ranges. In addition, we have installed the electric moving shooting galleries on the rim fire range. Currently, we have two machines installed with room for up to six more in order to accommodate future growth.

Finally, renewals have been pouring in. As of close of business today, 414 members have renewed. If history repeats itself, we will see renewals continue to pour in for the next couple months.

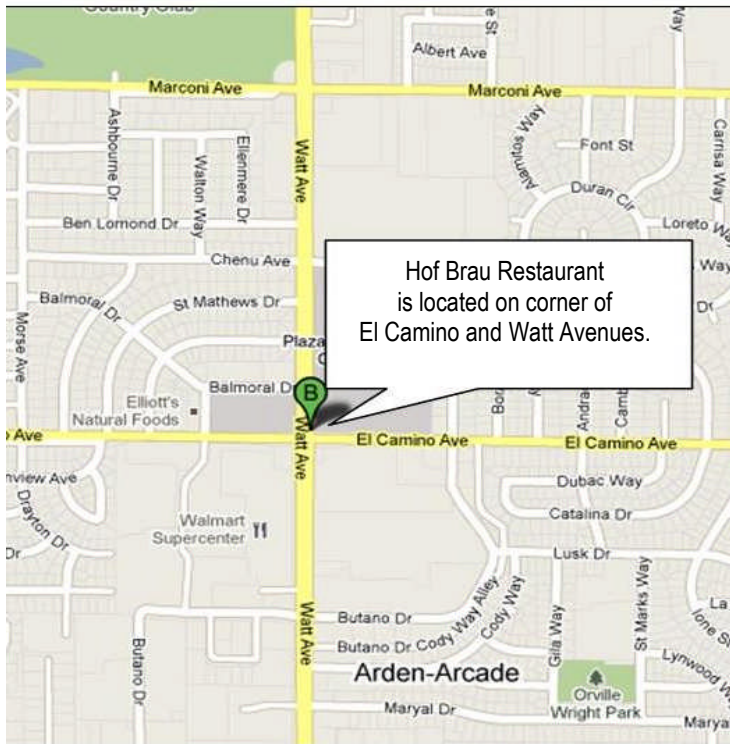

Recent changes in issuing policies mean that as long as you are not a felon or have been convicted of certain other crimes you are able to get a CCW. Self Defense is good cause, you don't need to be a banker! You do have to pass a background check and pass a 16 hour safety course. Sac Valley can help you with the training. We take your safety seriously at Sac Valley. Shooting is a very safe sport when practiced correctly. We require that all range employees become NRA certified Range Safety Officers, even our maintenance staff. We want you to take safety seriously too, so we have a few requirements for all shooters. Eye and hearing protection are **mandatory** for anyone on the range.

Please be aware that all firearms on the public range **MUST** use an empty chamber indicator during cease fire periods. Bring your own or buy one at the office for a nominal fee.
